[Mojolicious framework](#) in version v9.19 introduced additional padding, making all session cookies longer than supported SALT_MAX of regular HMAC-SHA256 cracking modules: [mojolicious/mojo#1791](#)

This merge request introduces a modified version of JWT cracking module, reusing big chunks of code, but changing the input format to accommodate such cookies.
