Title	TOTOLINK A720R V4.1.5cu.374 Exposure of Sensitive System Information to an Unauthorized Cont
Description	The TOTOLINK A720R V4.1.5cu.374 firmware contains an unauthenticated system information disclosure vulnerability. An attacker can exploit this flaw by sending a crafted POST request with the parameter {"topicurl":"getInitCfg"} to /cgi-bin/cstecgi.cgi, exposing sensitive device configuration details including firmware version, hardware model, supported network features, operational modes, and system parameters.
