# Personal Weather Station Dashboard (PWS\_Dashboard) Long-Term-Support version December 2020 (2012\_lts)

Real user-website(s) to get an idea what you could build yourself:

- The test/demo website shows an "out of the box" version of PWS Dashboard
- This <u>website in the UK</u> uses a large weatherstation and has enhanced and extended about 20% of the blocks
- This website in the Netherlands uses pwsWD as a dashboard-only (without a menu a.s.o.) in its weather-website
- This Canadian website included a self-written script to replace the default AQ block, an extra footer and other goodies
- This Chinese website added its own language to the standard 17 supported languages.

Check also the <u>demo of the **simplified** dashboard format</u> which is often used as an "extra console" on a (spare) tablet.
