Description	<p>Adianti Framework has multiple PHP Object Injection vulnerabilities as a result of Deserialization of Untrusted Data.</p> <p>(POP/) Gadget Chains exist in Adianti Framework (and its libraries) which allow Object Injection vulnerabilities to be exploited, for example to delete arbitrary files. Other attacks may be possible depending on what additional code is used in a given project.</p> <p>Most functionality within Adianti Framework requires authentication by default, and all of the vulnerabilities require authentication. Low user-level privileges are sufficient.</p>
